


It is intended that the first responder inspector perform basic-level inspections, which will include specific code and standard sections. However, it is not intended to cover the detail or depth that a fire inspector would provide. The AHJ should establish specific direction and training for the first responder inspector that defines and outlines the basic items that should be covered, such as through a checklist or itemized list of specific codes and standards. See Annex I for an example of a checklist that could be used by a first responder inspector.

- Reduces conflicts between standards
- Reduces meeting costs for volunteers
- Provides opportunities for committees to coordinate
- Arranges (almost) all ERRS standards into 5 groups, revised every 5 years








